Parenting 2 Part Workshop – As part of our Faith and Family Night activities, we are excited to offer a workshop featuring dynamic speakers from *Connected Families*, a Twin Cities-based organization that provides quality, Christ-centered help for families. The workshop is entitled **Discipline That Connects**. Here is a summary: *“What kids learn when they are disciplined will last a lifetime. But well-intentioned parents miss their kids’ hearts during discipline. It happens all the time. Instead of building the wisdom and respect they hope for, parents inadvertently build discouragement and resentment, which drives their kids to misbehave more. But it doesn’t have to be that way!”* Parents will learn to communicate four powerful messages that all children need to hear: you are safe, you are loved, you are God’s workmanship, you are responsible. Last weeks session was very well attended and many positive comments have been shared. The fee for the two week class is \$10 per person or \$15 per couple. The last session will be held Wednesday September 28th from 6:15 – 7:15 p.m. Come for dinner at 5:30 and stay for the class if able.

Coming in October! Starting Sunday, October 2nd, Pastor Steve will teach a new course during the Adult Education Hour at 9:30 a.m., called *The Story*. *The Story* is a fresh, effective way to study and understand the great themes of the Bible. Using selections from the Scriptures (*The Story: Scripture Book*) condensed into 31 chronological chapters, this course takes us from Genesis through Revelation. Each class begins with a 10-minute teaching video, followed by discussion from *The Story Participant’s Guide*, which is filled with time lines, discussion questions, list of Bible characters, charts of biblical events, and more.
