**Training coming soon**—for volunteers in our Braille Work Center. Redeemer has entered into partnership with Lutheran Braille Workers to produce and distribute Braille Christian Bibles and Christian materials for people with visual impairment. **Ability to read Braille is NOT a requirement.** All that is needed is a commitment of 4 hours of your time each month to help with collating, assembling, punching, binding, checking and shipping materials. If interested in volunteering, please pick up a Procedures Manual prior to the training session to familiarize yourself to the whole operation of the Work Center. **The Story, Bible Study**—Pastor Steve continues to teach a course during the Adult Education Hour at 9:30 AM called *The Story*. *The Story* is a fresh, effective way to study and understand the great themes of the Bible. We have reduced our trash pick-up since starting to compost and lowered our Randy's Sanitation bill by \$35 per month.
