Security Donations Needed—To modernize our security for the church and school, The Board of Trustees has researched and selected bids from several security companies that have offered a security package that will utilize state of the art equipment and techniques for approximately \$30,000. There has already been a generous donation from a school grandparent for \$10,000. MMLG (Missions/Ministries Leadership Group) has discussed this and would like to ask for donations to acquire the remaining funds necessary. The system would be designed to provide security by limiting access to the building by unauthorized persons during school hours, and also provide security to the church and school during non-school hours. The system will use key fobs instead of keys to provide access to the building, which will eliminate the need to rekey the building if a fob is lost. Cameras and motion detectors will be placed within the church and school to provide security 24 hours a day. This will provide additional security when outside groups are in the building by monitoring/controlling their access.
